SOME HELPFUL HINTS TO PREVENT YOU FROM BECOMING A VICTIM:

- 1. Don't leave your purse or any other valuables in plain sight in your car, even if it is for a short period of time.
- 2. If you get telephone solicitors of any kind for work to be done in your home, such as, pest control, carpet cleaning, roofing, plumbing, heating or air conditioning, just simply say you are not interested or that you have already had that service done. The way I look at this tactic, is these are services you should request yourself instead of being solicited.
- 3. Be sure when you go out of town to have a neighbor or relative take care of your house by picking up the paper and mail everyday. Buy some inexpensive appliance timers for your lamps and radios so your house looks lived in and not empty. If you are going to be gone for a long period of time, consider having someone mow the yard.
- 4. Leave a key and important numbers with someone you trust in case of emergencies.

Also remember, the O.N.A. has a very reliable and trustworthy service that is available to you at a reasonable rate for house-sitting or pet-sitting. • What size hailstone is large enough to actually cause damage to my roof?

A: Typically, a "golf ball" size hailstone or larger can cause damage to your roof. The older

your roof, the more susceptible it will be to sustaining damage from hail. However, any roof, regardless of age or product durability, can be significantly damaged by hail, depending on the size, velocity, and duration of the hailstorm.
