INFORMATION FOR PROPERTY OWNERS

A lot of questions have been asked lately in regards to "who is responsible" for the brick walls that surround the perimeter of Oakridge.

The maintenance of the brick walls is the responsibility of the property owner - just as the front parkways and the area behind the fences are. The repairs for the walls should be paid by the person's insurance, which was responsible for the damage. Information (Accident Report) can be obtained at the Police Department. Give them at least 2 or 3 days after the damage, so it will be in their computer system.

If there has not been an Accident Report filed, then the property owner needs to file with their homeowner's insurance company.

For the most part they are well fed and cared for. We don't all have them registered with the ONA hotline - it is something I have been meaning to do, but just haven't gotten around to it! Why don't we at least have collars with tags on them to show where they belong? They are house dogs and NEVER get out. WRONG! They do get out. Our dogs get out on a regular basis. They have a fenced in back yard and some how manage to escape. They are always returned to us because they have collars with tags on them with the dogs name and our name address and phone number. These collars don't have to be tight or heavy or expensive. You can buy both collars and tags at any pet store or your Vet's office for under \$10.00!

This is for your benefit as well as your dog. Dogs adjust to a new environment a lot easier than you can adjust to having lost a pet that you loved and cared for. To loose a pet is heart breaking, but to loose one because you didn't take the time to put a collar with tags on it, is careless. If the dog is sick, or hasn't had all its shots, or requires some special food or treatment, these are all things that take time for someone else to learn and in the mean time, it may be painful for your pet to have to go through until they learn. It may even cost the animal it's life in the process. So if you care enough to have a pet, take the time to put a collar and tags on it! Then when the little escape artist gets out - you'll get your furry friend back in a timely manner, without searching the neighborhood for days!
