# **Private Mortgage Insurance**

## How Long Is It On Your Loan?

Private mortgage insurance exists on all loans when the loan to value ratio is less then 20%. Now that the market is changing and we are experiencing a

gradual increase in values you may want to check your equity. If you have paid down on your loan and your value has increased you may have equity in your home equal to 20% or more. If so, you may petition your mortgage company to take your PMI off of your loan. This will save you a monthly fee that is not a deductible item on your taxes. In recent years, some buyers have signed, at closing, documents that state that the removal of the PMI is at the discretion of the mortgage company. They may or may not require an appraisal to do this. Persistence will usually payoff in the event that the company does not respond immediately, but it is at their discretion. It is the same principle as taxation. The government is quick to raise taxes in a market that is increasing, but it is up to you to petition the local taxing authorities to have your taxes lowered when your values decrease.

A Realtor can give you a market analysis and some mortgage companies may accept them. It is at the discretion of each company whether or not they will require an appraisal. In some cases you have to pursue mortgage companies to remove the PMI, but it is well worth the effort. A savings of 50.00 per month equals 600.00 per year and \$ 6,000.00 for 10 years and \$ 12,000.00 for 20 years.


