### **Keeping Yards Beautiful**

Let's take advantage of the cooler temperatures to clean up our yards and keep Oakridge looking beautiful. From campaign signs to compost, we have a few resources to help you get started.

- Campaign Signs. What can you do with those political campaign signs for your favorite candidates? The Internet is loaded with dozens of greats ideas for using those old signs - just search for "reuse of campaign signs". Some ideas include:
  - 1. Reuse Paint the sign and use it for another occasion (such as a Birthday celebration or your next Garage Sale).
  - Recycle Garland residents may place the corrugated-plastic sign tops (without wire stakes) in their curbside recycling carts (i.e., your Blue Bin). Important: make sure to REMOVE the wire stakes before placing signs in the recycling bin. Wire stakes can be taken to Garland Recycling Center at 1426 Commerce Street.

- Composting. Have you tried composting? It is an

  additive to improve the clay soil in your flower beds.
